IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. <u>Unable to sign</u>: If you are unable to sign your application form yourself, please contact us on 0121 464 2929 to obtain a waiver form.

2. <u>Validating your postal ballot</u>: Applications to vote by post are scanned on to our computer system. When you receive your postal ballot paper you will also receive a Voter's Statement, which requires you to provide your signature and date of birth. If the signature and date of birth on the Voter's Statement does not match the signature and date of birth you provided on your original application, your vote cannot be counted.

3. <u>When are postal ballots delivered?</u> Postal ballot papers are sent out approximately one week before polling day. If you are going on holiday more than a week before polling day, please contact us on 0121 303 9454 for advice.
